OF THE OTTERBEIN UNITED METHODIST CHURCH**

WHEREAS the Otterbein United Methodist Church located in Woods County, Oklahoma was founded September 25, 1909, and has had a long and proud history; and

WHEREAS the church conference of the Otterbein United Methodist Church voted on September 2, 2007, to discontinue the church; and

WHEREAS the district superintendent has recommended discontinuance of the Otterbein United Methodist Church and transfer of membership to the Alva First United Methodist Church; and

WHEREAS the consent to discontinue has been granted by the presiding bishop, a majority of the district superintendents, and the district Board of Church Location and Building and all proper Disciplinary requirements have been compiled with;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Otterbein United Methodist Church be discontinued effective September 2, 2007, and that the property shall be sold and proceeds paid to the Woodward District Board of Trustees in accordance with the *Discipline* and the Conference Standing Rules.
