

Local Church Recommendations for Conference Officers

Any church that wishes to recommend persons to serve as conference officers is asked to affirm that recommendation at their charge conference.

The process is:

- 1) The local church committee on Lay Leadership will create an additional category in their nominations, "Persons recommended for service as conference officers." This list should include those members of the church already serving as conference officers.
- 2) In addition, nominations may be made from the floor of the charge conference.
- 3) Those elected by their charge conference will have their names submitted to the district superintendent and be listed in the conference database (Brickriver) by the recording secretary of the charge conference. The list must include the person's name, mailing address, phone number, and E-mail address.
- 4) The district superintendents and the conference "Nominating Committee" will use this list of recommended persons when making annual nominations for conference officers and for filling vacancies on conference committees.
- 5) Inclusion on this list does not guarantee that the person will be asked to serve, but it does affirm that the local church recommends this person, should their service be needed.
